Vuzix Announces a Major Software Upgrade to the Video iWear® VR920; expanding supported titles and Vista compatibility.

The Upgraded VR920 v2.0 software now supports 40 popular game and simulation titles using virtually any graphics card in Windows XP or Vista

Rochester, NY – March 5th – Vuzix Corporation is excited to introduce the first in a series of highly anticipated upgrades for the VR920 virtual reality eyewear. The iWear® VR920 v2.0 software includes expanded title support for its Vuzix 3D Stereoscopic video drivers, enabling users of most popular gaming titles to enjoy their favorite game in 3D video.

For iWear® VR920 users, 3D video support was previously limited to titles supporting Nvidia 3D Stereo on computers equipped with Nvidia graphics cards and difficult to configure 3D drivers. These drivers were available for only a limited number of Nvidia graphics cards and were not Vista compatible. Using the new Vuzix 3D drivers, iWear® VR920 users are now able to enjoy any of the 40 supported titles with virtually any make or model of graphics card running under Windows XP or Vista.
